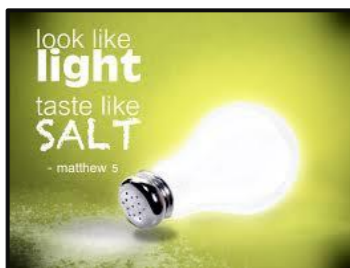

Church Council Update:

At Bethel's annual congregational meeting last February, we discussed the need and building of a new Education Wing. A Building Committee was appointed – they are Bernie Wiebe, Howard Heide, Ernie Peters, Peter Klassen and Jesse Voth. They've met with the leaders of the different programs involved – children's church, Awana, Sunday school, Jr & Sr Youth and others to determine their wants and needs. Basic drawings have been made and we're waiting for cost estimates. Plans are to move or take down the old sanctuary and construct on that site. Spring construction could start if congregation approves the project and all the plans come together.
