BETHEL BERGTHALER MENNONITE CHURCH RENTAL POLICIES

The Bethel Bergthaler Mennonite Church facilities are set apart as a place to worship God, pray, teach the Word of God, and enjoy Christian fellowship. Please respect the mandate of this congregation as you enjoy the use of our facilities. By having a representative of the rental group sign the rental agreement, all people involved in the rental agree that they will not teach, practice or promote anything contrary to our Statement of Faith (as attached) during their rental.

General Policies:

1. Smoking, liquor or intoxicants are not allowed in any of the buildings or on church property.
2. No throwing of confetti and/or rice is allowed in any building or on church property.
3. Decorations should be placed with consideration to not do any damage to the church property and the custodian's permission is required prior to furniture, plants or decorations being moved.
4. Candles must be placed in containers.
5. Children shall be supervised and not left unattended.
6. No rentals will be allowed for use of the gym/fellowship hall by a sports team for practices or games.
7. Rentals requiring extensive clean up (example: fundraisers) will not be accepted for Saturdays.
8. The Church's sound and video equipment shall only be used by qualified individuals that are approved by Bethel's sound personnel.
9. Any damage to the buildings, property or equipment will be billed to the renter.
10. The custodian(s) will meet or communicate with all rental contacts that require the use of the gym and/or kitchen to discuss what is needed and allowed in those areas. The Custodian's phone number is 204-362-6222.
11. All set up and clean up (tables, chairs, stage, etc.) is the responsibility of the renter or part of the rental agreement if they choose to pay for this service as indicated on the rental agreement. Communication about all rental details need to take place between the renter and the custodian(s). Clean up instructions can be found on the instruction sheet attached to the walk-in cooler door.
12. WI-FI is available with all rentals. The password is given upon request.

Booking and Financial Policies:

1. All requests for rentals are to be submitted in writing by filling out the Rental Application and will be considered confirmed only when the booking has been approved by the assigned representative of Bethel Church and the deposit or full payment has been submitted. We reserve the right to refuse a rental.
2. All rental bookings must be made at least 2 weeks prior to the rental and can be made no more than one year in advance. Funerals would be an exception to this policy.
3. Church events take priority over rentals.
4. All rentals are to vacate the church buildings by 10:00 PM on weekdays and Sundays and 9:00 PM on Saturdays. Exceptions can only be made if negotiated and agreed upon by the custodian and the renter.
5. All wedding rentals include access to the church the day prior to the wedding no earlier than 9:00 AM.

BETHEL BERGTHALER MENNONITE CHURCH CONFESSION OF FAITH

1. We believe that the Holy Scriptures, the Old and the New Testaments, are the Word of God, divinely inspired and infallible, the only trustworthy guide; in faith and life.
2. We believe in the one, living, true and triune God who exists from all eternity as God the Father, Creator, Sustainer and Ruler; God the Son who became fully human and fully God in Christ Jesus; God the Holy Spirit who is one with the Father and the Son who indwells believers.
3. We believe in a visible church, the body of Christ, made up of those who through repentance and regeneration have come to the Christian faith, have received the Holy Spirit, and have become members of the fellowship on earth. Jesus Christ is its head and foundation. It is responsible to preach the Gospel to all people according to the command of Christ. It will be characterized by its evangelical faith, teaching, love, behavior, works and the observance of its ordinances according to the command of Christ. It will be preserved by Christ until the end of the age of grace.
4. We believe in the following biblical ordinances:
 - Baptism:**
We believe that all who through repentance and faith in Christ have been regenerated and have become children of God, should, upon confession of faith submit to water baptism according to Christ's command.
 - The Lord's Supper:**
We believe in the observance of the Lord's Supper as a privilege and a responsibility of believers, celebrated as a memorial of the suffering and death of our Savior Jesus Christ and for fellowship with God and with fellow believers. We believe further, that each person who partakes of this meal needs to go through a self-examination in order to be in true fellowship with others and with the Lord.
5. We believe in the institution of marriage of one man and one woman who are of one faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. Such a union should not be dissolved by separation or divorce.
6. We believe that the ordination of pastors and ministers is taught by Holy Scripture, and shall be carried out in accordance with the teaching of Scripture.
7. We believe in the biblical teaching of peace, love and non-resistance as Christ Himself practiced this in His life and as we learn it from the teachings of Christ and the apostles.
8. We believe in affirming the truth, therefore we do not practice swearing an oath on the Bible.
9. We believe in the practice of church discipline according to New Testament teaching.
10. We believe that we have been called with a holy calling to live a life of separation from sin and the world.
11. We believe in the personal, visible, imminent, premillennial return of Christ.
