Details for ordering pizzas: The pizzas are Large (14 inch), hot and ready to eat. You can select from Hawaiian, Pepperoni & Bacon, Double Pepperoni, or Cheese pizza. Pick up will take place over 3 days, Jan. 31-Feb. 2. Orders must be placed no later than Jan. 30, 10:00 PM.
